1.0 Background

The organization has over 16 years' experience implementing evidence-based adolescent and youth programs in over 345 institutions of learning (Primary, Secondary and Higher learning institutions) across 26 Counties in Kenya. ICL aims at contributing towards improved life opportunities of adolescents and youth aged 10-24 using a holistic transformational model. ICL employs evidence to design and run innovative and high impact interventions to improve key indicators in health, education, economic empowerment and leadership and governance with regards to children, adolescents, and youth. The two (2) year project funded by ERIKS Development Partner.

Following the rich experience and vast understanding of the contextual barriers behind educational marginalization for girls, the potential that exists amongst them and their communities, Jielimishe ERIKS Project (JEP) seeks to empower girls and improve their learning outcomes and their household using a transformative gender equality lens. The project thus aims at improving the Life Chances of 550 marginalized primary school learners and young mothers/older girls aged 10 to 24 Turkana West Sub County through gender equality in education by 2023.
